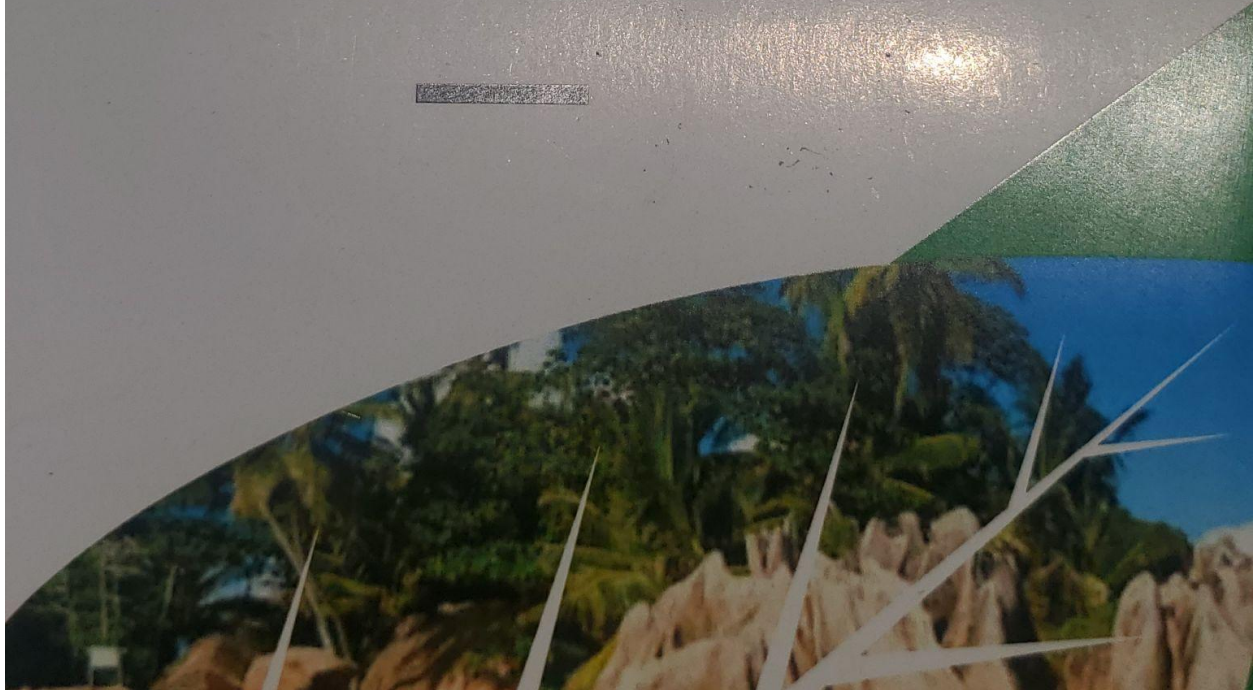

REAL ESTATE

Investors can lease land from the government and/or buy land from the private sector. Investors wishing to lease land from the government have to submit a project proposal to the SIB. As such, it is advisable to identify a site before a project proposal is submitted. Purchase of land or property from an individual. When the seller is a private individual, the investor should contact a notary or attorney who will manage the transfer of ownership of the plot which will then be registered at the Registration Division.

TOURISM

Since the opening of the Seychelles International Airport in 1971, the tourism sector has been central to the Seychelles economy. The natural beauty of the 115 islands as well as the unique creole culture have not only attracted a growing number of visitors, but have also caused the islands to be a magnet for regional and international companies looking to invest in this sector. Each year, more visitors are coming to the islands with 384,201 tourists recorded in 2019. Europe remains Seychelles' main tourism source market, with highest visitor arrivals from Germany, France and UK.
